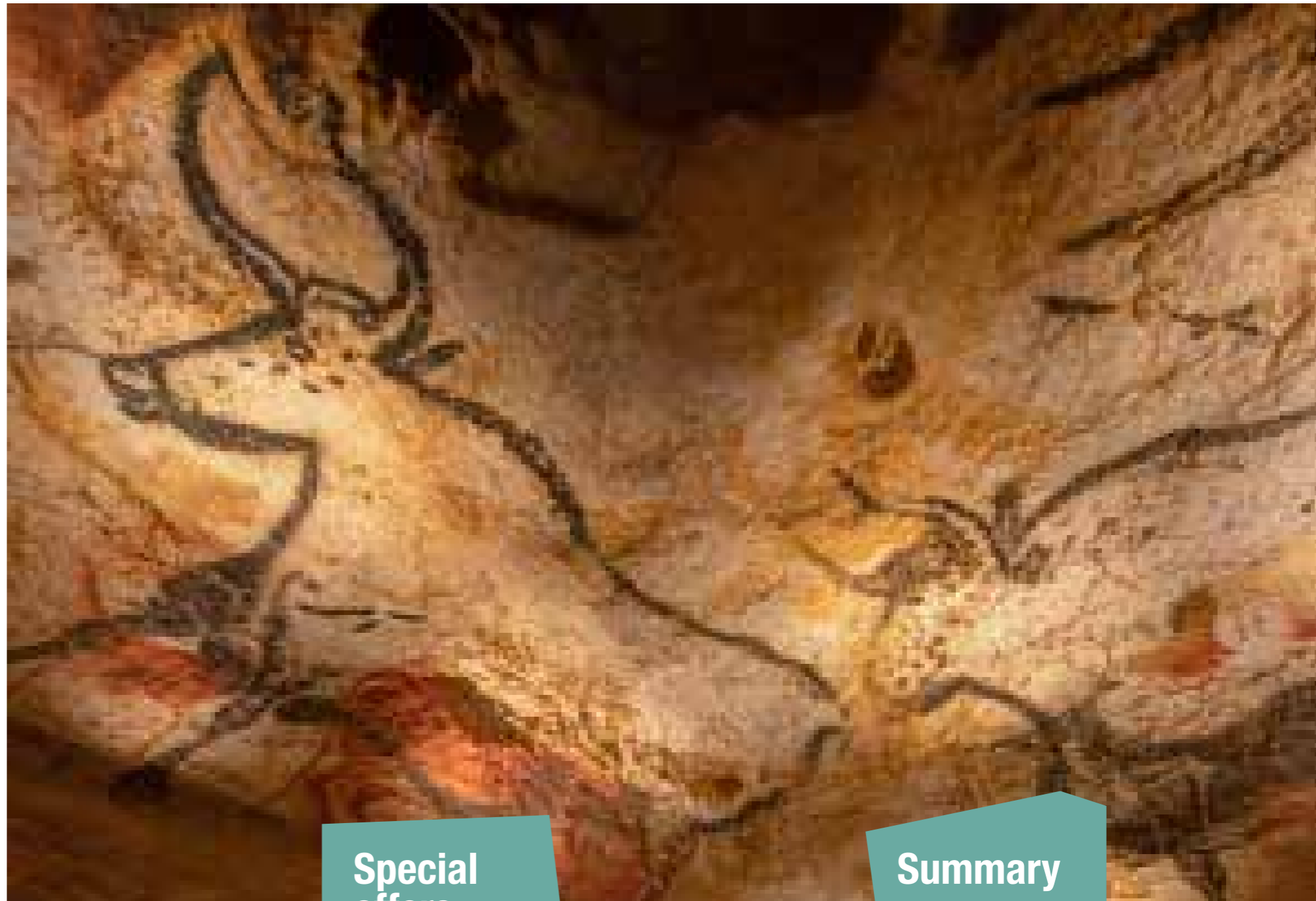

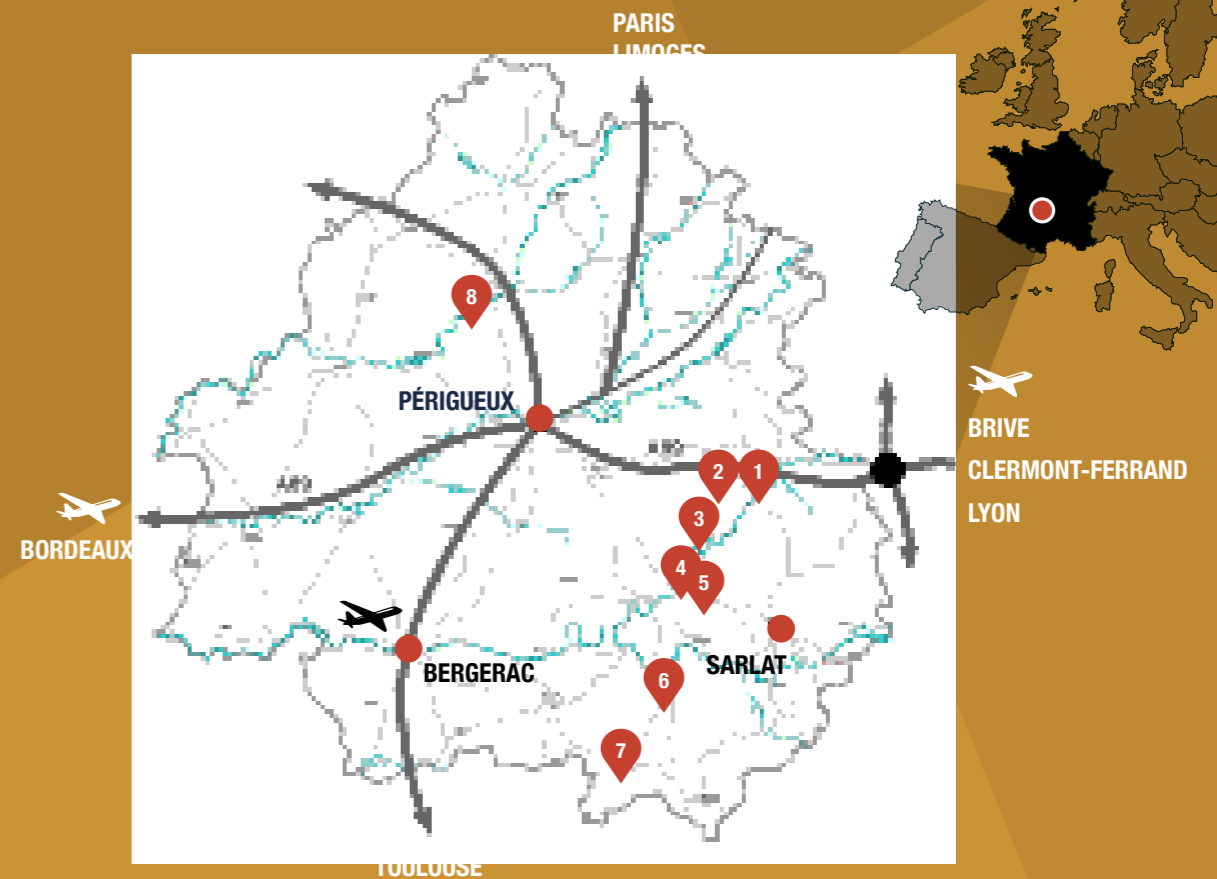

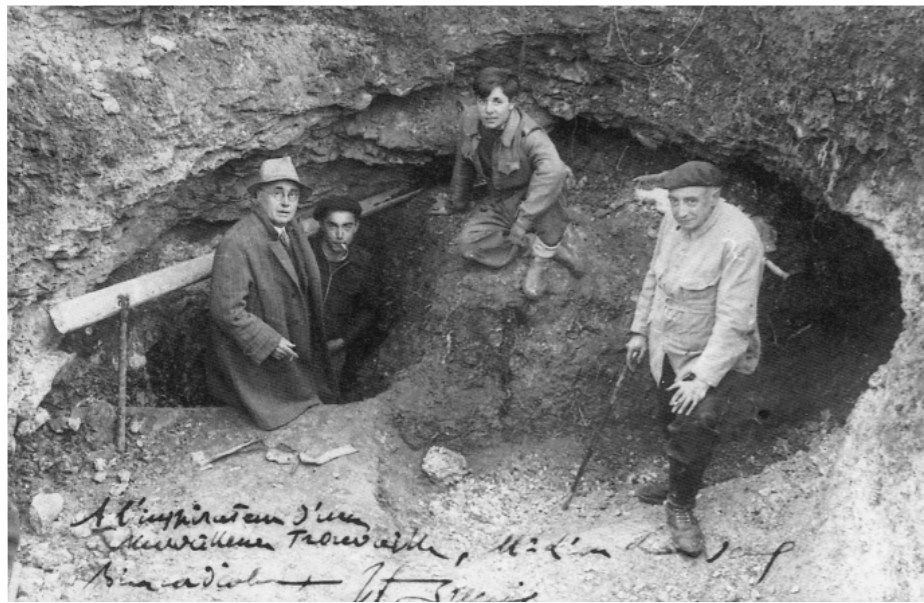

1940

1940
The Lascaux caves are discovered and listed as Historic Monuments

1948
The caves welcome their first visitors

From 1955 to 1962
Appearance and advancement of damage to the calcium deposits due to very high visitor numbers

1963
André Malraux, France's culture minister, decides to close the caves and to prevent access to the general public due to the damage to its paintings

1972
Work starts on building a reproduction of the caves, the world's first recreation of its kind

1979
The caves are added to the list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites

Lascaux, the world's best-known site for cave art is an absolute must-see!

With around 2,000 engraved and painted figures revealing its incredible natural history, it is widely regarded as one of the most important sites for Palaeolithic cave art, and undoubtedly one of the best known. And its discovery in September 1940 by four intrepid teenagers also helped to guarantee its fame. Often called the "Sistine Chapel of prehistory" for the quality and quantity of its depictions, it never fails to amaze.

At Lascaux IV, visitors can now explore the replica of the cave in its entirety with an unprecedented level of detail! The cave paintings and engravings, which date back more than 20,000 years, are brought to life to delight visitors of all ages. Thanks to the innovative use of resources and technology, visitors are given a unique immersive experience, as well as the opportunity to meet our teams, marvel at the extraordinary architecture, and discover the links between cave art and contemporary art... Timeless Lascaux is just waiting to be explored in a thousand different ways through the range of tours available.

When you visit the Périgord, then a visit to Lascaux IV is a must for anyone who has ever thought about our origins, as well as being the perfect introduction for a journey into prehistory at the heart of the Vézère valley.

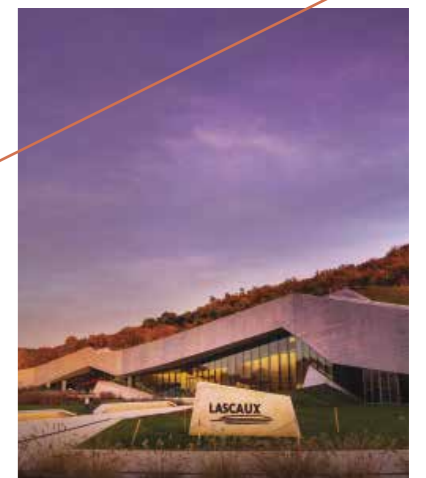

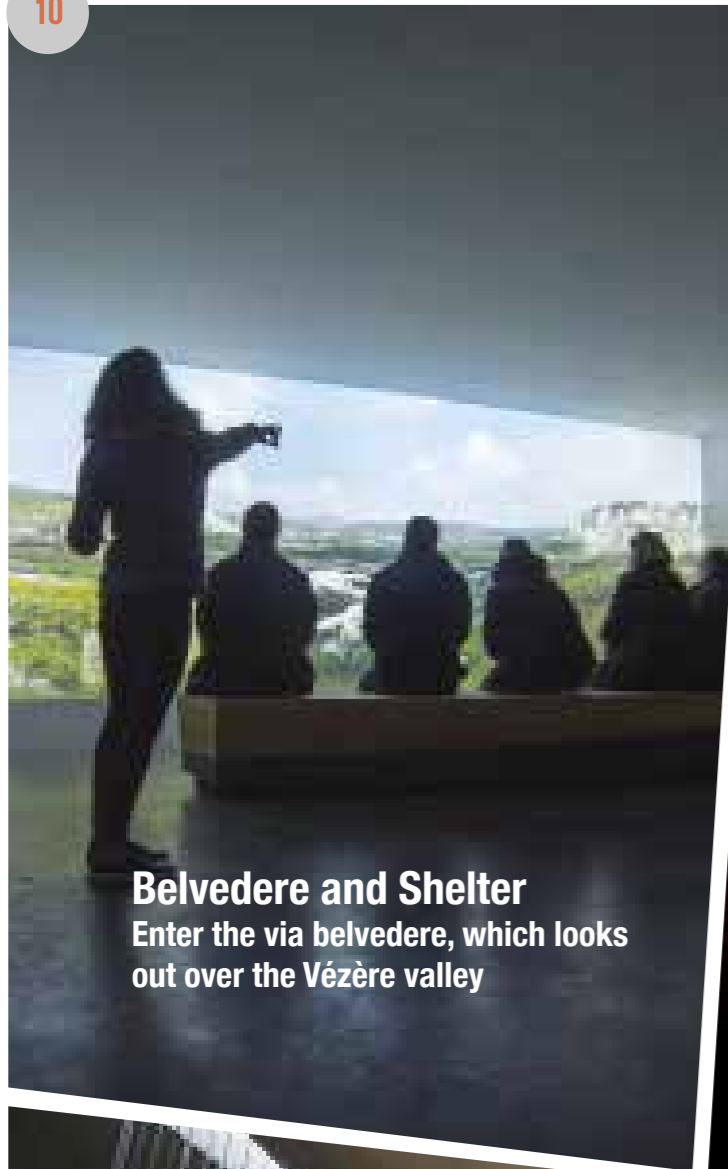

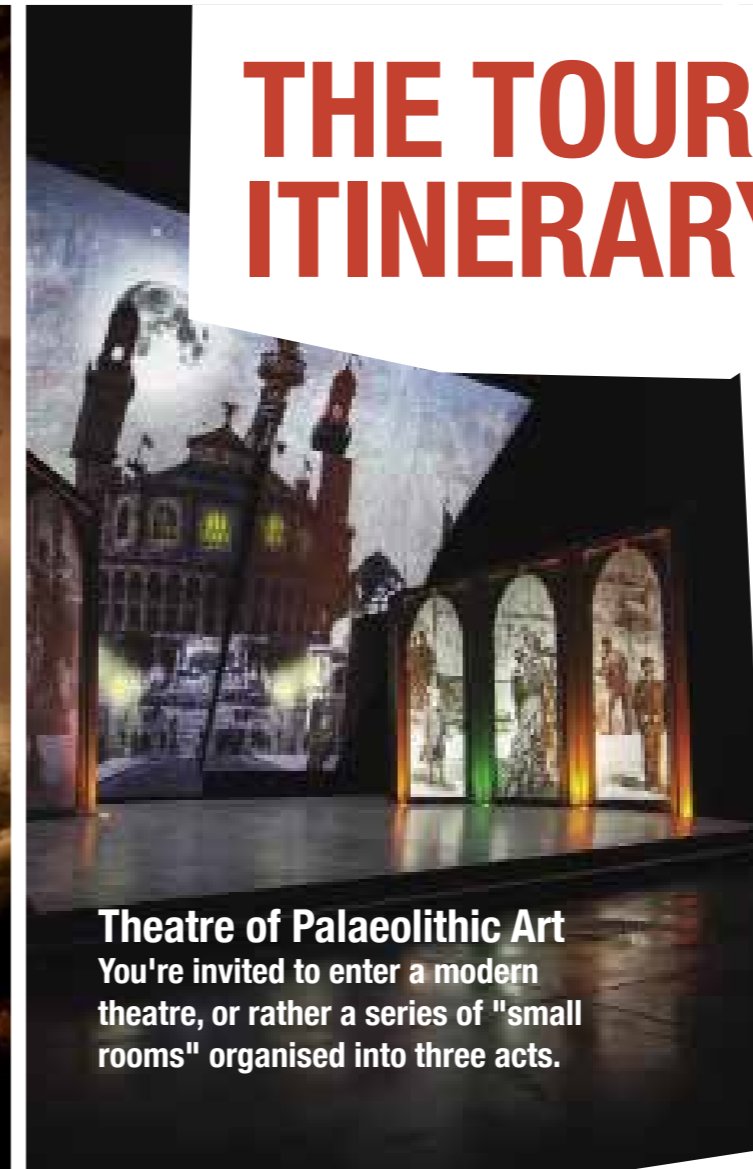

The Caves

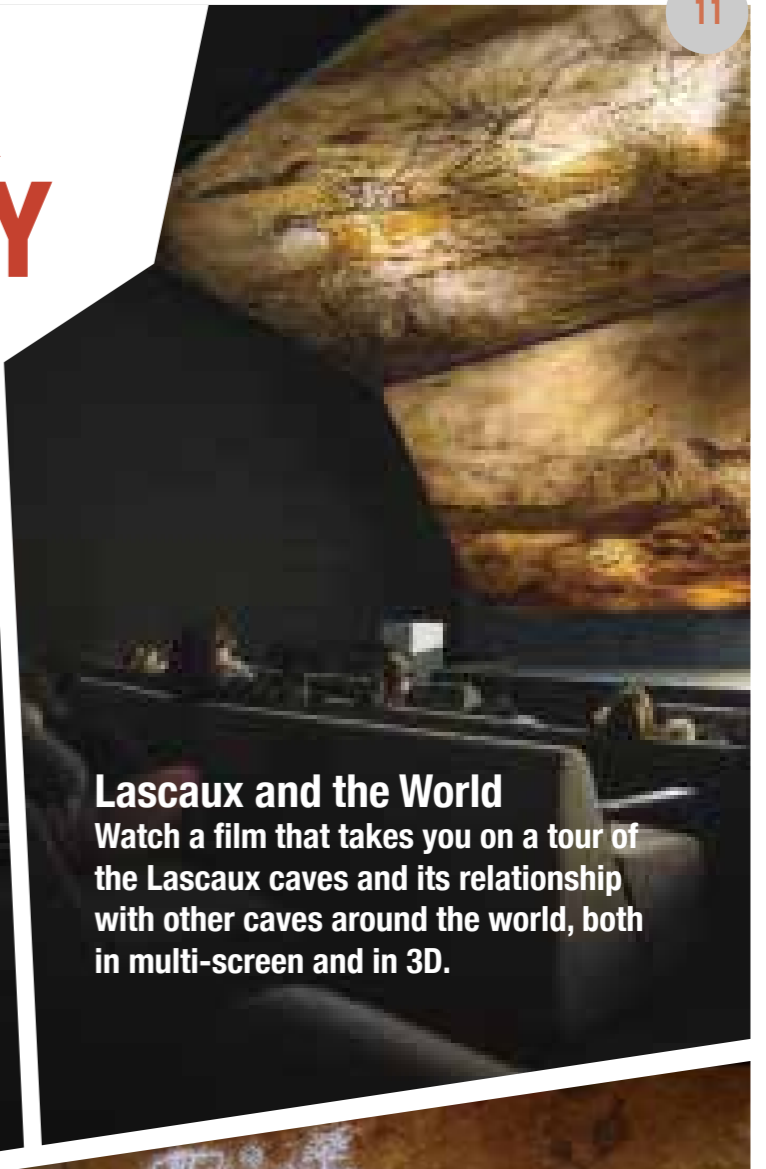

You're invited to enter a modern theatre, or rather a series of "small rooms" organised into three acts.



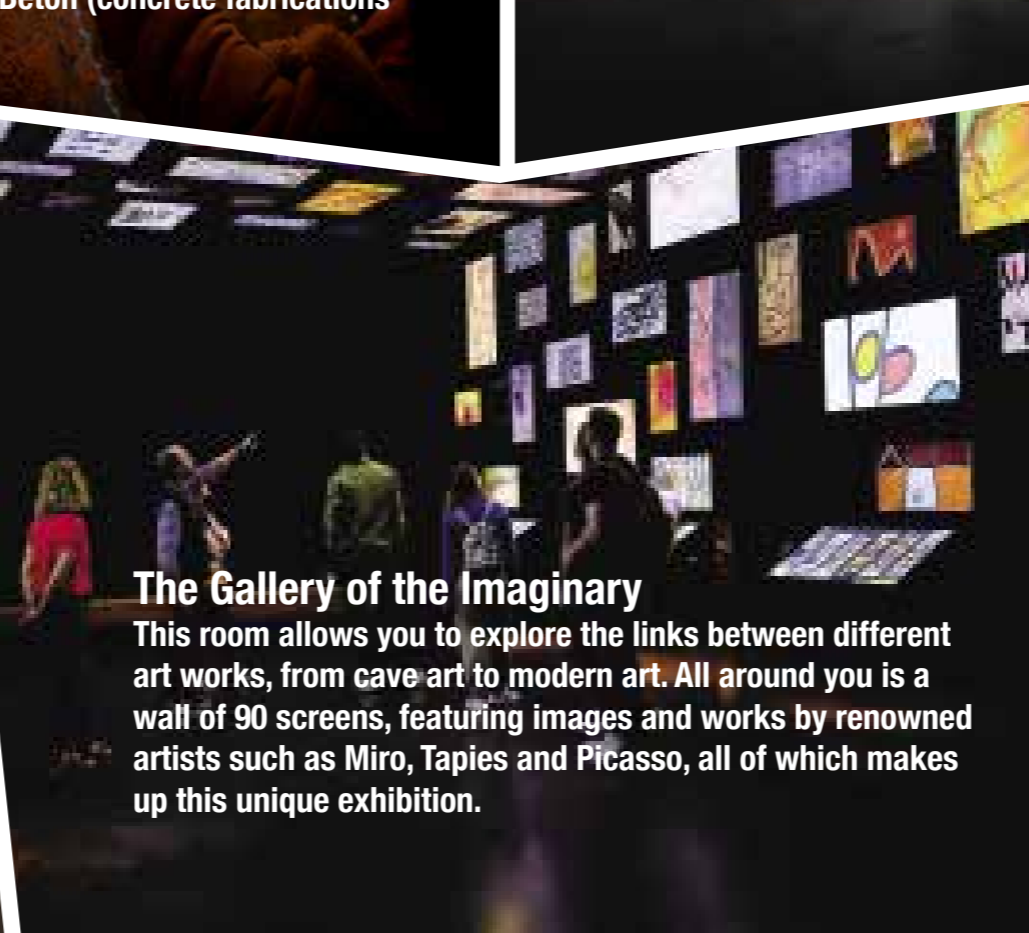
Lascaux and the World

Watch a film that takes you on a tour of the Lascaux caves and its relationship with other caves around the world, both in multi-screen and in 3D.



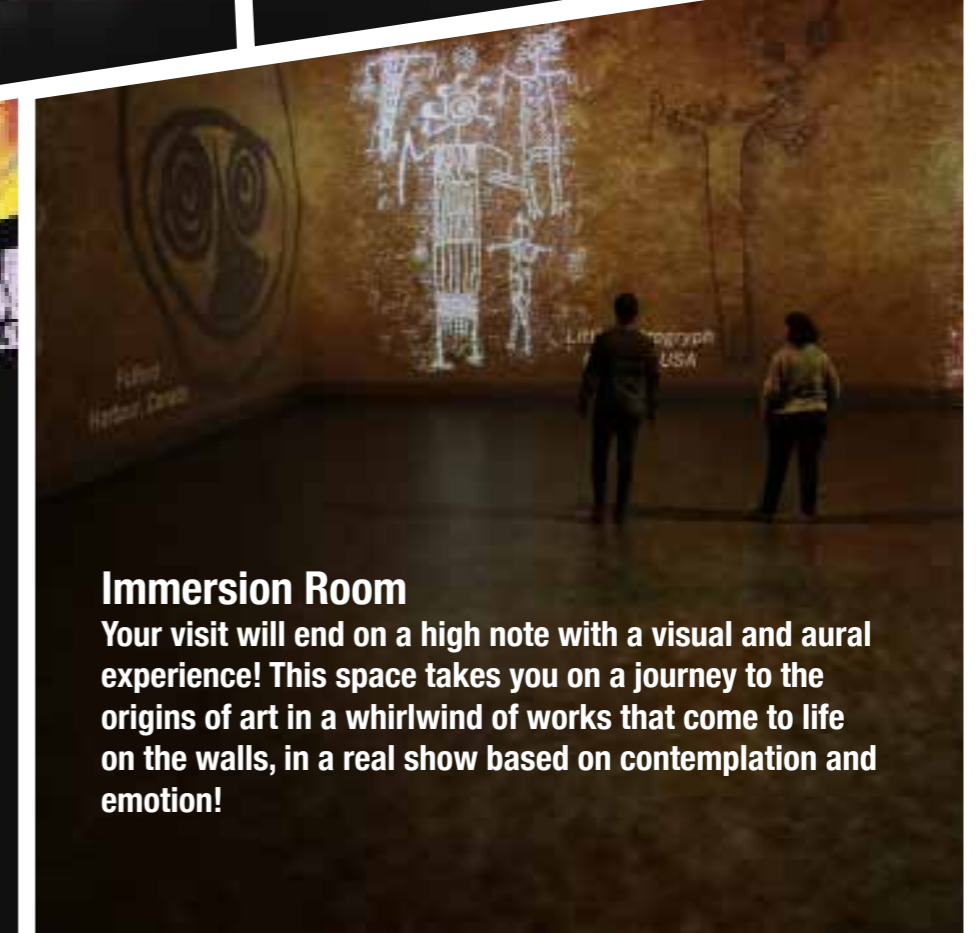
The Lascaux Workshop

The Gallery of the Imaginary

This room allows you to explore the links between different art works, from cave art to modern art. All around you is a wall of 90 screens, featuring images and works by renowned artists such as Miro, Tapes and Picasso, all of which makes up this unique exhibition.

Your visit will end on a high note with a visual and aural experience! This space takes you on a journey to the origins of art in a whirlwind of works that come to life on the walls, in a real show based on contemplation and emotion!

Full tour of the International Center for Cave Art

2hrs - 2.30hrs

This visit is a real opportunity for your customers to explore and understand Lascaux and its connection with humanity.

The tour begins at the Belvedere and the Shelter with an introduction to the setting and landscape of the Vézère valley 20,000 years ago, before moving on to the caves for almost an hour. Inside the reproduction, the guide will help them think about their own origins while surrounded by the depictions left by the hand of our Cro-Magnon ancestors. After this timeless moment, equipped with a digital tablet they pass through visit five different areas, each of which add a new dimension to the visit to the caves: The Workshop, the Theatre of Palaeolithic Art, the "Lascaux and the World" cinema, the Gallery of the Imaginary and the Immersion Room. THE CAVES OF GRAND ROC

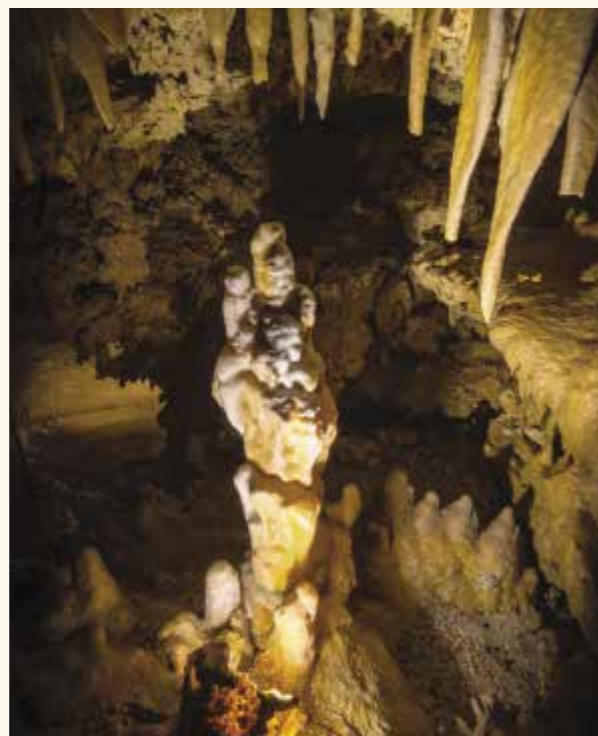

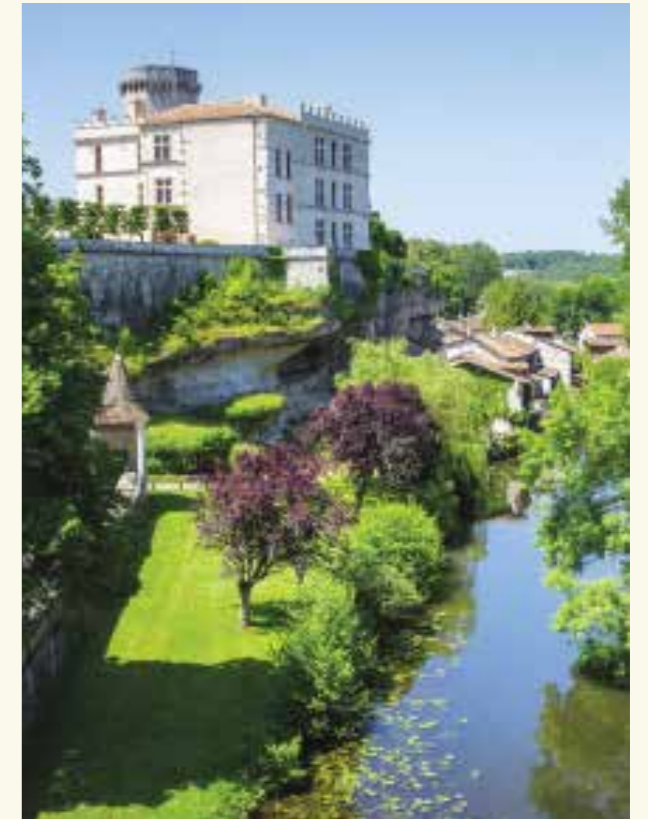
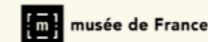


CHÂTEAU DE BOURDEILLES

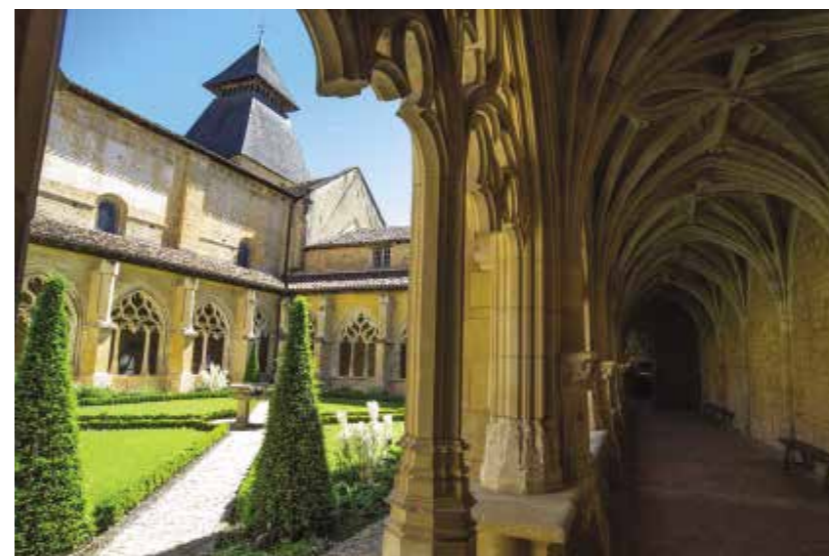
